

INDIVIDUAL ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

Membership is open to individuals aged over 16 living in any area within East Ayrshire not covered by a constituted local tenant or residents' association.

The following rules apply as outlined in the constitution: -

- Individuals who support the aims of the Federation will be eligible to become non-voting Associate Members. This is to encourage wider involvement and the setting up of democratic associations in areas that are not yet organised.
- Individual Associate members may stand for election to the Committee as detailed in clause 4 d) of the Federation's constitution
- Individual Associate Members may at the discretion of the Committee be appointed to participate in a voting capacity in any sub - committees that are appointed in accordance with clause SU) of the constitution
- Where more than two individuals from the same locality apply to join the Federation, they will be encouraged by the Federation to set up a local association. Individual Associate Membership will end at the next Federation AGM following the establishment of a member association in the appropriate area.
- Organisations that share the aims of the Federation will be eligible to become non-voting associate Members.
- Granting of individual or Associate Membership will be at the discretion of the Committee.
